What is the National Team Development Centre?

- ▶ We are a community-based organization designed to develop elite cross-country skiers who will represent Canada at international competitions such as the Olympic Winter Games, World Championships, World Cups and World Junior Championships. NTDC strives to attract athletes to Thunder Bay through high-performance programming that enables them to reach their full potential. Through community outreach, our athletes act as role models and ambassadors for healthy active living, showing the community and youth what it means to work hard towards a goal, and exemplifying good health and sportsmanship. NTDC Thunder Bay is one of 3 national training centres working together across Canada under the direction of Nordiq Canada, the national sport organization (NSO), and alongside Cross-Country Ski Ontario (XCSO) our Provincial sport organization and partner (PSO) and the Canadian Sport Institute Ontario (CSIO) to provide individualized training, and competition programs and support.
- ▶ Each year, up to 15 of the top cross-country skiers from across Canada are selected to join NTDC Thunder Bay based on a performance-based criteria. The Centre provides these individuals with national level coaching, high level training facilities, and excellent sport science testing. Our athletes' rigorous training programs average between 600 to 800 hours annually. They train 11 months of the year and compete at regional, national, and international competitions from November to April. Their demanding training and competition programs are often blended with post-secondary education at Lakehead University or Confederation College right here in Thunder Bay.
- ▶ Over the past 28 years, our coaching support has included Canadian and Finnish national level coaches. Currently, the Centre is led by Head Coach Timo Puiras and Team Manager, Leslie Bode. Together, they deliver individualized training plans, and world class coaching and competition support, which is essential for the success of both the team and the individual athletes.
