NTDC-Thunder Bay is seeking an Assistant High-Performance Coach for the Summer of 2023. The Summer Assistant High-Performance coach will work in partnership with the NTDC Head Coach and the Assistant Coach and Manager to deliver, coordinate and monitor the summer dry land training of NTDC Athletes.

The NTDC works within the framework of Nordiq Canada's system of training centres to provide elite cross-country skiers with intensive training and competition programs. Athletes from across the country are selected based on national performance criteria to participate in the NTDC program, providing these dedicated individuals with national level coaching, access to extensive high level training facilities and excellent sport science testing services.

Term: Commencing - 01 June (tbc)-August 31st, 2023 / Salary commensurate with the applicant's level of experience

General Responsibilities:

These include but are not limited to the following:

- Work with coaches to plan, coordinate and monitor training, race preparation and competition of athletes
 ensuring long-term vision and periodization of training and racing to optimize athlete development and
 performance.
- Deliver, coordinate and monitor weekly training sessions.
- Assist with testing and monitoring
- Collaborate with the Integrated Support Team and coaches to implement and monitor training plans, optimal athlete preparations, including strength and conditioning, mental performance, health, nutrition, and competition plans.
- Work with coaches to coordinate team travel, logistics, monitoring team budget, expense tracking and associated reports. Assist with fundraising events, social media posts and media releases.

Desired Qualifications and Coaching Development Pathway:

- The ideal candidate will have experience leading teams of athletes, coaches and support staff at national level competitions. International experience is considered an asset.
- Working towards Coaching Competition Development/Level 4 certified/CCD + CDAG trained. We will also consider high performance athletes who have recently started their coaching certification training.
- Leadership skills to develop and contribute to the development of a high-performance team and to build strong relationships and credibility with athletes, coaches and support staff.
