Who are we?

We are NTDC, one of Canada's 3 National Team Development Centres for cross country skiing excellence in Canada. We proudly call Thunder Bay our home and have done so for over 30 years. Our team consists of athletes who were born and raised in Thunder Bay, athletes from across Ontario, as well as from across Canada. We are part of the fabric of this community.













Yet, our sport is **chronically underfunded** and we are asking for your support to help these **phenomenal athletes** pursue their passion and represent Canada. We currently have an **Olympian**, **a Youth Olympian**, as well as two Canadian age group champions on the team.

We are the **home of some of Canada's top athletes**. Last year alone athletes from NTDC Thunder Bay represented Canada in the following events:

- Youth Olympic Games (South Korea): Cedric Martel (U18), Lappe Nordic
- World Juniors (Slovenia): Clara Hegan (U20), Nakkertok Nordic
- World Cup (Norway and Sweden): Pierre Grall-Johnson (Senior), Nakkertok Nordic
- World Cup (Sweden and Finland): Graham Ritchie (Senior), Georgian Nordic
- World Cup (Minneapolis): Pierre Grall-Johnson, Nakkertok Nordic; Julian Smith, Georgian Bay Nordic; and Clara Hegan, Nakkertok Nordic
- World Cup (Canmore): Pierre Grall-Johnson, *Nakkertok Nordic*; Julian Smith, *Georgian Bay Nordic*; Erikson Moore, *Fondeurs Laurentides*; and Adam Heale, *Black Jack*

These athletes are phenomenal members of the community. Many attend **Lakehead University** while pursuing full-time high performance skiing. Additionally, **they coach and mentor younger athletes** in the community and across the province **while holding down part-time jobs**.

They also pay for this sport out of their own pockets. Amateur sport is chronically underfunded in our country. Nordiq Canada, Cross Country Ski Ontario and the Canadian Sport Institute of Ontario provide partial funding for staff and administrative support, but athletes bear the majority of the costs. It costs each athlete between \$15,000 and \$30,000 per year (in addition to the cost of pursuing their education) to develop their passion, and represent Canada.
